(c) Provide **four** examples of the matters considered on the form.

At trial, Moreton Home Interiors Ltd are successful in defending the claim.

(d) Explain how the matter of costs was dealt with throughout the case up to, but not including, the final hearing.

Your client is successful at trial. You advise your client that in the future she may wish to use Alternative Dispute Resolution (ADR).

(d) Explain the benefits of using ADR.
