Question 1

Reference: Question relates to **Document 1** of the case study materials.

Following his meeting with Mary Fletcher, Thomas Andrews has doubts about Mary's capacity to make a new Will.

(a) Explain why medical evidence on Mary's mental capacity should be obtained.

(6 marks)

(b) Explain the tests in <u>Banks v Goodfellow</u> (1870) that would be used to determine whether Mary has mental capacity.

(4 marks)

Medical evidence is obtained, which confirms that Mary does have the mental capacity to make a Will and a Lasting Power of Attorney.

- (c) Draft paragraphs to go in a letter to Mary explaining:
 - (i) the powers that an attorney will have under a Lasting Power of Attorney for Property and Financial Affairs;

(5 marks)

(ii) the powers that an attorney will have under a Lasting Power of Attorney for Health and Welfare;

(5 marks)

(iii) when the attorneys can exercise these powers.

- (a) Following Thomas Andrews' meeting with Denzil Lewis, he would like you to draft paragraphs for inclusion in a letter that he is going to send to Denzil, explaining:
 - (i) a home reversion plan;

(ii) the advantages of a home reversion plan;

(5 marks)

(iii) the disadvantages of a home reversion plan.

Having received Thomas Andrews' letter, Denzil decides not to go ahead with a home reversion plan.

(b) Explain which welfare benefits Denzil would be entitled to, in order to renovate his house and to pay for his care at home.

(c) Explain the Inheritance Tax implications for Denzil's estate, if he died within seven years of giving his property to his daughter Rosemary.

Following the meeting with Ahmed Khan, Thomas Andrews asks you to draft paragraphs for inclusion in the letter he is going to send to him dealing with the following:

(c) Explain the procedure for registering Ahmed's mother's Enduring Power of Attorney with the Court.
