

### Role of Group Chair (Independent member)

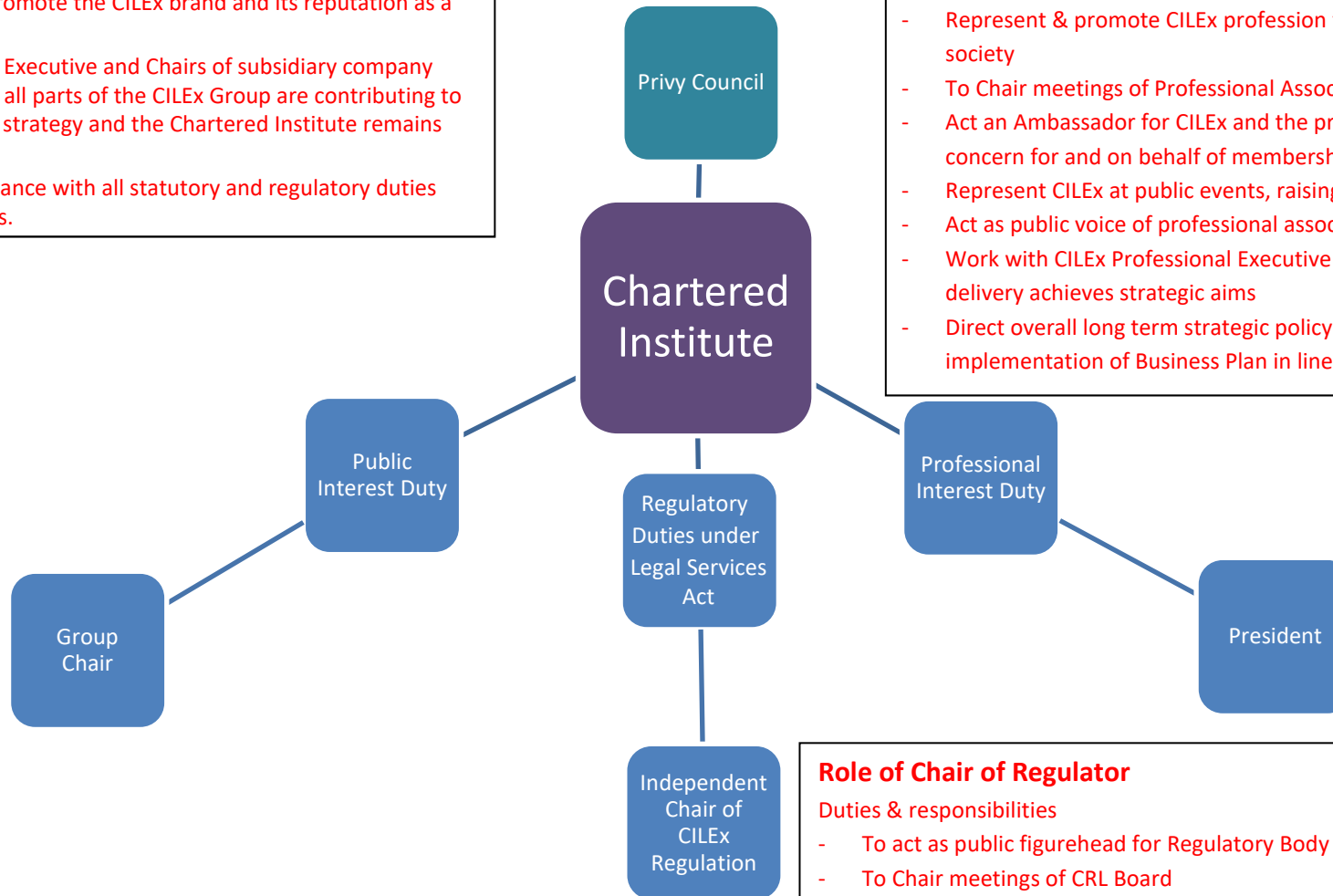
Duties & responsibilities:

- To act as public figurehead for Chartered Institute as a body with a public interest duty.
- To Chair meetings of Group Board.
- To protect and promote the CILEx brand and its reputation as a Chartered Body.
- To work with the Executive and Chairs of subsidiary company Boards to ensure all parts of the CILEx Group are contributing to a cohesive group strategy and the Chartered Institute remains financially viable.
- To ensure compliance with all statutory and regulatory duties and requirements.

### Role of President (Fellow appointed from within Professional members of CILEx Professional Association Board)

Duties & responsibilities

- To act as public figurehead for both the Professional Association & Awarding Body
- Member of Group Board
- Represent & promote CILEx profession to government, legal sector & society
- To Chair meetings of Professional Association Board and Awarding Body
- Act an Ambassador for CILEx and the profession, raising issues of concern for and on behalf of membership & legal sector
- Represent CILEx at public events, raising profile and standing of CILEx
- Act as public voice of professional association
- Work with CILEx Professional Executive team to ensure operational delivery achieves strategic aims
- Direct overall long term strategic policy for professional association & implementation of Business Plan in line with Vision approved by Council



### Role of Chair of Regulator

Duties & responsibilities

- To act as public figurehead for Regulatory Body
- To Chair meetings of CRL Board
- Represent & promote CILEx Regulation to government, legal sector & society
- To ensure compliance with Regulatory Objectives of Legal Services Act delegated to CRL as per Protocols
