We wrote to you last week to let you know that the Level 3 and Level 6 exams would be delivered online during the week of 7th September. To clarify, this applies to all examinees, regardless of where they are sitting their exams.

In our communication, we said you would hear from us regularly between now and September. We will be sending emails, such as this one, weekly, to provide you with the latest information and updates. We have also added new material to our dedicated FAQs on the CILEx website including further details about:

- The exams deferment deadline – please note that this is Friday 24 July 2020
- Exam conditions and regulations, including invigilation information
- Grade boundaries
- Membership upgrade
- January 2021 exams
- External exam centre fee

In addition to messages from us, if you are registered to sit your exams at an Accredited Centre rather than at one of our External Examination Centres (as most distance learners are) you may receive communications directly from your centre about their individual arrangements for the September examination session. We are working closely with them to ensure that they can offer you a safe and secure environment to sit your exams.
